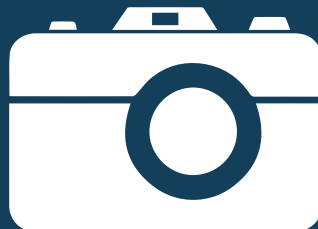

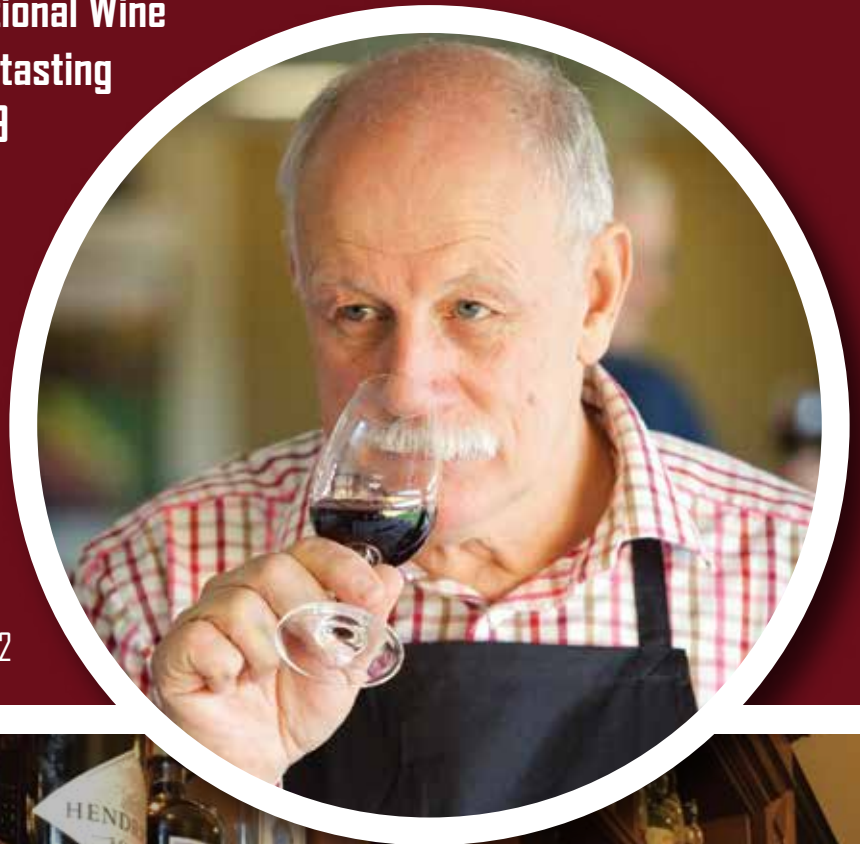
Thursday 4th October 6.30pm to 8.30pm
