There was a significant \$60,000 turnaround in trading with the Club returning a trading profit for the 2018 financial year.

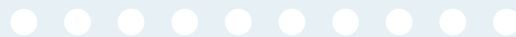
Very positive feedback was received to the changes within the Club in the last year.
